




# **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**


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	INSTALLATION PROCESS	
1	Note original ride height measurement from center of rear fender arch to ground.	
2	Safely lift the truck and support on jack stands.	
3	Remove rear wheels.	
4	Unbolt factory bump stops.	
5	Reinstall factory bump stops with provided alumimum spacer and longer bolt with THREADLOCKER applied to the bolt threads. <b>Torque to 15 lb.ft</b>	
6	Fit Air Spring assemblies to frame. <b>NOTE - If equipped</b> with fifth wheel hitch, first remove the hitch frame mounting hardware. Use the supplied hardware to attach the upper air spring brackets to the outside of the frame or hitch through the frame mounting holes.	
7	On the driver side, bend the E-brake bracket on the U-bolt saddle downward to make room for the lower bracket. Install the provided sheathing around the e-brake cable where it contacts the lower bracket.

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INSTALLATION PROCESS CONT'D			
8	Secure the lower bracket to the leaf spring with the supplied carriage bolts, straps, washers and nuts. <b>Make sure the bracket is centered over the U-bolt saddle</b> and snug the nuts.		
9	For the driver side front bolt, use the supplied 1/2" carriage bolt and square washer with the wire bolt lead. Feed the bolt through the frame mounting hole above the DEF or fuel tank (depending on configuration).		
10	Install all other 1/2" hardware with bolt heads on the inside of the frame. Snug the nuts.		
11	Before torquing the nuts, ensure that the upper bracket legs are tight against the bottom of the frame rail. <b>Torque 1/2" Hardware to 110 lb.ft</b>		
12	Install the frame hooks on the inside of the upper bracket with the supplied 3/8" hardware. Snug hardware then push hook tightly against the frame rail. Tap with a mallet if needed. <b>Torque to 44 lb.ft</b>		
13	Torque all lower bracket hardware to 20 lb.ft		
14	Mount inflation valves at desired location using a 5/16" drill bit.		
15	Route air line from each inflation valve to each air fitting tee on both of the air spring assemblies. Avoid hot exhaust and sharp edges. Cut air line square and free from burrs with air line cutter or razor blade!		
16	Final Safety Checks:		
• (	Check for leaks at fittings with soapy water		
• (	Check tire clearance to air spring (more than 1")		
• \	Verify all fasteners are torqued properly		
Verify at least 10 psi in air springs before driving
